



## **VABORBACTAM TESTING NOW AVAILABLE**

Bensalem, Pa. November, 2019:

ADL developed Vaborbactam testing. Vaborbactam is a  $\beta$ -lactamase inhibitor based on a cyclic boronic acid pharmacophore [A32053]. It has been used in trials investigating the treatment of bacterial infections in subjects with varying degrees of renal insufficiency and was approved by the FDA for the treatment of adult patients with complicated urinary tract infections (cUTI).

**Test Number:** 6968

**Collection Requirements:**

- 1 ml Frozen Serum/CSF collected in red top tube with no additive or in a sterile container
- At least 100-300 Microliters Frozen Serum/CSF for Pediatric Samples.

**Result TAT:**

- Routine: within 24 hours of receipt of specimen
- STAT: within 8 hours of receipt of specimen
